

LX NEWSLETTER EDITOR

The LX Club is seeking a new Editor for its Newsletter when the current Editor steps down from the role after several years in post.

The Role

The role of the LX Club Newsletter Editor, a committee position, is to keep the club membership informed of what is happening in LX and the wider world of Masters hockey for the over 60s and older age groups, and any impact that this might have on us as individuals. This often includes information from England Hockey, World Masters Hockey and the World Grand Masters Association.

Currently, a Newsletter is issued quarterly. In general, it probably takes around 5-6 days effort over the course of a quarter to gather all the information, draft the Newsletter and then update following peer review by committee members. Uploading the Newsletter to the website is undertaken by the Website/Database Manager.

The Scope

The scope of the content is wide ranging and could include international travel issues, health matters as well as club and wider hockey related issues. Innovative ideas are always welcome. The information is usually obtained from the many available websites, information passed to the Hon Sec from external organisations and hockey associations, club committee meetings and also from Club members. Clearly the scope, presentation and frequency is the Editor's choice and it could be amended as seen fit.

It is advantageous to have a working knowledge of Microsoft Word or a similar word processing application, e.g. LibreOffice (was OpenOffice) Writer. Other than that no specific IT skills are required!

Anyone wishing to express an interest in taking on or exploring the role further or should contact the current Editor, the Hon Sec or the Chairman before the end of May.
